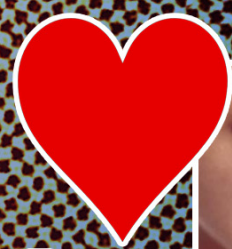




# The New-Birth & Your Heart & Your Mouth



The New-Birth, Your Heart & Mouth

**Romans 10/8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach):**

*The gift of eternal life is never further away from you than your mouth & heart!*

*The divine laws of God are present in the Earth, & anyone acting upon these laws is subject to the results of these divine principles coming to pass, including the receiving of divine life through the principles of confession & possession!*

*The wisdom of God set the principles of redemption into existence before the creation of Adam, the first man, by God's pre-planning for the manifestation of Jesus, the Last Adam!*

*By the grace & love of God, anyone calling upon Jesus for salvation will receive it, resulting in them being Born-again & becoming a New-creation!*

**9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.**

*Everything that needed to be done to bring the eternal Godhead into union with fallen mankind was done for us by Them, & all that remains for anyone to do to come into union with God is to call upon Jesus for salvation, which results in the Holy Spirit taking up residence inside of that person, placing the divine life of God in them, & recreating them spiritually with the image & likeness of the Holy Trinity coming forth in them forever!*

*Note what it is that you confess & believe regarding salvation:*

*you declare Jesus to be your Lord, & you believe that He was raised from physical & spiritual death (3 days after His death on the cross).*

*You commit the act of putting your personal trust into Jesus for the life & benefits of salvation when you act upon the principles of confession & belief!*

**10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.**

*Both righteousness & salvation are gifts of God that are freely & fully given from the Heavenly Father through the Holy Spirit at the moment you call upon Jesus. Nothing in creation can hinder, alter, or reverse the transformation that takes place in an 'atomic-second' inside of you when you confess Jesus as your Lord! These principles of redemption that we act upon when we receive the gift of eternal life are divine, constant, & eternal!*

*The pathways to your spirit are your mouth & heart, which team up in the act of receiving salvation, & doing so releases the Holy Spirit that's around you to move into you, as the 'Breath of Life'.*

*With the gift of eternal life, you receive the life of God, the Spirit of God, the nature of God, & are Born-again of the Word of God, & with all of these divine elements being eternal, everything about your recreated spirit becomes eternal, once & for all of time!*

**11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."**

*Here is a 'hidden nugget' of eternal life!*

*Right in the midst of the revelation of how to receive eternal life, here's a promise of security for the believer!*

*Anyone that receives the gift of eternal life is saved, sealed, seated, & secured into union with the Father, Son, & Spirit!*

*Though verse eleven is a quote from the Old Testament, it is strategically placed into this passage by the Holy Spirit, to confirm a truth that was alluded to centuries before: the promise of eternal life would come through the Seed, the Lamb, the Son, The Bright & Morning Star, the King of Kings, Lord of Lords, Jesus!*

*Could there be anything that would cause more shame than to lose eternal life, if that were a possibility?*

*Believing in Jesus as the Lamb of God that carried away the sin of the world, & calling upon Him for redemption & eternal life places you into God & God into you forever! In the redemption that Jesus provided & the Holy Spirit brought into you, you're permanently released from sin, condemnation, guilt, fear, & shame, & you're sealed into God's holiness, righteousness, justification, sanctification, & perfection. This verse above reminds us of the reality of eternal life: 'eternal' means that it can't be lost, doesn't fade, & won't erode away! Just as Romans 8/1 tells us that there's no condemnation to you once you're placed into Christ Jesus, there's also no guilt, shame, failure, nor blame! The shame that we were filled with wasn't due to our behavior, but because of our spiritual nature.*

*God's life entering into us releases us from the nature of sin & fills us with the nature of righteousness, which can't be revoked by God, demon, or man!*

*Once you've been cleansed from the shame of having a fallen nature, you're free & clear from it forevermore, & you're free from sin, judgement, & rejection by God!*

**12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him.**

*God is no respecter of persons, which means that He doesn't offer to anyone that which He doesn't offer to everyone!*

*The people of Israel were the original people called by God in order to bring forth Jesus, & Jesus brought forth the Church, His own Body, which is created through faith in Him!*

*Here again, we have the promise of God's unfailing faithfulness towards anyone & everyone that calls upon Him for salvation & any other need, for the Lord richly blesses those that call upon Him.*

*You can't get any more blessed than to have everything Heaven offers without the possibility of ever losing it, right?*

**13 For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."**

*Anyone that operates in these principles of salvation receives eternal life & everything that comes with it!*

*To be saved doesn't only mean to be forgiven of sin, but also means to be redeemed, sanctified, justified, & glorified in union with Jesus Christ!*

*To be saved, by Bible definition, means to escape Hell, be joined to Heaven, receive eternal life, & become cleansed from all blemishes of your character.*

*In union with Jesus, we are holy, complete, mature, secure, & can be sure of our salvation. The perfection of Christ Jesus has been imputed to us legally, & imparted into us literally, & we have no imperfection before God, or in our union with Him!*

**17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.**

*The literal faith of Jesus enters into you with the Holy Spirit when you confess the Lordship of Jesus into your life!*

*The life of Jesus comes into you through His Word which inhabits you from the split-second you call upon Him!*

*The Spirit of God brings the life of God which brings the faith of God, all at once, when you call upon Jesus!*

*When you're Born-again, you become spiritually complete in your union with Jesus!*

**As He is, so are you in this world (1 John 3/17).**
